Additional COVID-19 Safety Measures at West Row

COVID-19 remains a serious issue and whilst flying at West Row is permitted, members must adhere to the following temporary safety measures.

1. Maintaining adequate social distancing is a critical requirement and in order to facilitate this, a maximum of **6** people may be on site at any one time:
 - no more than **3** people flying at one time.
 - those not flying to maintain social distance in, or close to, their cars
2. Members should leave 'one car's length' between each parked vehicle.
3. Members should use the club flying calendar to log when they plan to fly.
 - Estimates of arrival and departure times must be included to help others plan their visits.
 - Members **must not** turn up to fly without first checking the calendar and booking a slot.
4. Access to the container and toilet is now permitted; members must equip themselves with suitable gloves and hand sanitizer and use them as appropriate for their own safety and that of others.
5. Members must follow the West Row Daily Procedure, viz, complete the Daily Log sheet and use the club mobile phone to contact Mildenhall ATC. A copy of the procedure is posted on the Container wall.
6. Pilots must use the 'pilot boxes' marked out by barriers on the flightline.
